Susquehanna Community School District is seeking bids for the reconditioning of the districts asphalt parking lots at the Susquehanna Elementary and High Schools. Sealed Bids will be accepted by the business office until Monday June 18, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. At that time the district will open sealed bids at a public forum. Contract award shall be on June 20, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the next School Board meeting.

**WORK TO INCLUDE:**

**Crack-sealing:** Preparation shall consist of cleaning the cracks with an air broom, compressed air, high pressure heat lance if necessary. The melting kettle shall be of the double boiler, indirect heating type, thermostatically controlled using oil as a heat transfer. The sealing material must be agitated to prevent overheating. The sealing compound shall be PENNDOT or NYSDOT spec, rubberized-asphalt non-tracking hot-pour type conforming the following specifications: Federal Specification 3405 - ASTM D-1190-70.

**Seal-coating:** The entire area to be sealed will be thoroughly cleaned using a sweeper truck/ air brooms to remove accumulations of dust, dirt, loose aggregate, stone and other foreign material. Oil and gas accumulations will be treated with Prep-seal. Temperatures should be anticipated to be above 50 degrees for a 24-hour period. Each coat will be a slurry comprised of NEYRA Tarconite™ Coal Tar emulsion specifically formulated as a weather protective, water resistant coating for all asphalt surfaces, combined with clean dried sand. Sealcoat applied adjacent to curbs, sidewalks, concrete aprons, fences and other appurtenances shall be applied with care using special tools. Two full coats of sealer will be applied - Aggregate to be added at the rate of two to three pounds per gallon.

**Striping:** The surface to be striped will be done so by creating straight uniform stalls and roadway markings will be made using Sherwin-Williams™ Hotline traffic paint.

**WORKMANSHIP:**

- All work shall conform to the manufacturer's specifications and local and state building codes.
- All work to be done in a professional workmanlike manner in accordance with OSHA, local, state, and federal laws, ordinances, and regulations.

Awarded company shall be covered by workman's compensation insurance and by a minimum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) liability insurance, proof of insurance is required with bid and the Susquehanna Community School District shall be listed as an additional insured..

The project can start June 25, 2018. All work shall be completed by August 10, 2018.

The board of education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals.

All bidding contractors MUST schedule a site visit for your bid to be accepted. Contractors are responsible for field measurements and verification and submittals of all documentations to the district.

This project will be bid and completed in accordance with all Pennsylvania public project requirements. As such, the following is mandated:

- A bid bond or certified check in the amount of 10% of the bid must accompany the bid.
- The successful bidder will be required to provide a payment and performance bond in the amount of 100% of the contract.

The attached non-collusion agreement document must be completed and notarized and accompany the bid.

The contractor shall provide, in advance of start date, the following clearances, before any work can start:

- Act 34 – Pennsylvania Criminal History Reports
- Act 151 – Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearances
- Act 114 – FBI Fingerprint Clearances
- Act 24 – Arrest or Conviction Report (PDE, Form # 6004)
- Act 127 – PA Public Works Employment Verification Act

The attached Labor/Miscellaneous Requirements sheet lists all current regulations that you will be required to meet.
