Parent, Guardians, and Students,

Due to the recent rise in positive cases and recommendations from the Department of Health, we will be opening in a HYBRID learning model starting Monday, August 31, 2020. Students will be split into two groups while keeping families together on the same schedule. Please see the website for your students grouping and if you cannot access the website please call the elementary or high school office as they will be able to assist you. This move is necessary for the safety of all students and staff. Guidance and recommendations continue to change weekly from the Department of Health resulting in the need to change to a hybrid learning model.

Once students are in school, grades 7-12 will be issued a Chromebook, K4-2 an iPad, and grades 3-6 can borrow a Chromebook if needed until their Chromebook arrives. Grades 3-6 please email your building principal with the request if you do not have access to a device at home. Meet the Teacher Night is rescheduled to September 10, 2020 and will be virtual. These school issued devices should go home and come in each day with the student as they will be utilized both in the classroom and outside the classroom. Please ensure they are charged nightly and come in with a full charge. Elementary students can keep the charging cord at home.

We will stay in a hybrid learning model through October 2, 2020, and will reevaluate a few weeks prior to the end of the month. All decisions will be made using data from the county to ensure the safety of all.

I know this is not ideal or easy for anyone. We will continue to work with families to make this transition as smooth as possible.
