SCSD's Plan for Learning Loss (Mental Health)

SCSD will use \$80,000 of the grant to contract with a service provider to provide an additional mental health worker for the school district for the 2022/2023 school year.

The role of the mental health worker will be to:

- -provide individual and group counseling to district students and staff
- -provide professional development and support to district staff
- -support students in crisis

SCSD's Plan for Learning Loss (Professional Development)

SCSD will use \$19,000 of the grant funding to coordinate and provide professional development for district staff during the 2022/23 and 2023/24 school years related to the following mandated topics:

- a. Social emotional learning and support for students that have suffered trauma during the COVID-19 pandemic;
- b. Identifying signs of possible mental health issues and providing culturally relevant support;
- Motivating students that have been disengaged;
- d. Mentoring students who have attendance issues before it becomes a pattern;
- e. Self-care and mindfulness strategies for teachers;
- f. Engaging and communicating effectively with parents;
- g. Working with community agencies to address non-academic needs.

SCSD's Plan for Learning Loss (Professional Development)

Professional Development in grant target areas shall occur through the following trainings:

2022/2023: Self-Care & Mindfulness / Transformative Social Emotional Learning / Engagement and Attendance Strategies

2023/2024: Restorative Practices - Conflict Resolution / Bullying / Resiliency

SCSD's Plan for Learning Loss (Reading)

SCSD will use \$8,666 of the grant funding to purchase a reading software program to support struggling readers.

The program will be used with 50 struggling readers during summer and after-school programs.

Summer & After-School Programming

SCSD will use \$26,665 of the grant funding to operate a summer program during June and July of 2022 focusing on struggling readers from the economically disadvantaged subgroup in grades 3rd through 8th.

SCSD will use \$26,665 of the grant funding to operate an after-school reading intervention program focusing on struggling readers from the economically disadvantaged subgroup during October & November of 2022. The program will focus on struggling readers in grades 3rd through 8th.
