Professional Development

August is set to be a busy month as two trainings are scheduled prior to the start of the 2024-25 school year.

- Enhanced Core Reading Instruction Two days of training for Title I, Kindergarten and
 myself. This training is part of the plan developed by Mr. Supko for the Success for PA
 Early Learners grant. SPEL is a federal grant designed to improve school and family
 engagement, literacy skills, and continuity of transitions among educational systems for
 economically disadvantaged early learners at risk for, or identified with, a delay or
 disability.
- REWARDS One day training for grades 4-6 social studies teachers and myself. This program has the goal to increase fluency rates, deepen comprehension, and increase a more precise use of language. Time typically reserved for Social Studies will be paused until this enrichment has been completed at the start of the school year.

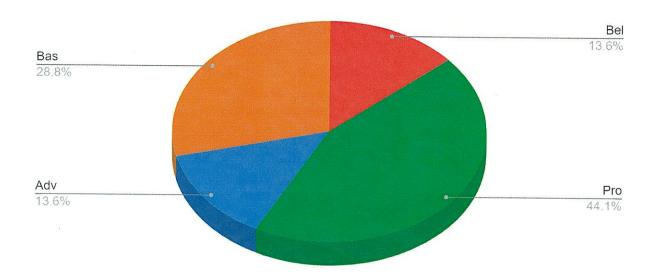

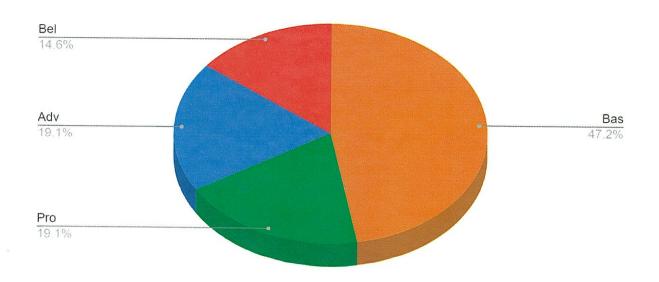

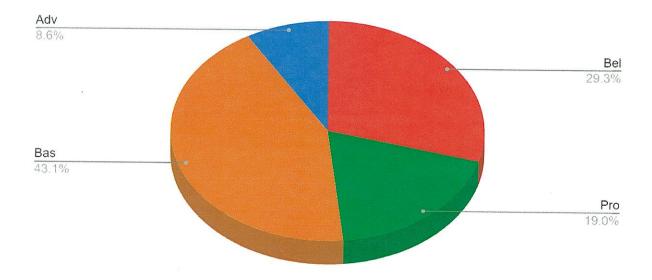
LIT Keystone Spring 2024 Results

Re: Business Office Report

Greetings, hope you are enjoying the summer weather.

The 2024-25 K-4 routes are complete. As of July 22, we have 33 pupils enrolled for the K-4 program. I am sure this number will change slightly by the start of school. The district will have one am and two pm sessions during the 24-25 school year. K-5 bus assignments are also completed.

We had to eliminate two buses, #4 and #10. There will be a 2nd tier run for local students that live on Broad Avenue. Bus 2 will make the run and it should not have a material effect on the students. Unless our contractors can attract new drivers, the district is headed to a two-tier bus system in the future.

2024-25 bus contracts will be completed once we receive the revised bus odometer readings for the current school year. This is usually completed during the months of September and October.

We will be meeting with bus contractors/drives in August to go over updates for the upcoming school year and to hand out bus rosters.

Brian Kelly and Associates will be on campus sometime in August to begin the 2024-25 audit. Audit planning will begin with bank reconciliations, bank confirmations and the reading of the school board minutes.

Tax bills were printed and mailed to our tax payers on July 1, 2024. No material issues to report at this time. There were minor typos reported on the school tax bills. Nothing material enough to result in the reprinting of the 2024 tax bills. Tax collections are progressing well.

We will be reporting the 2023-24 transportation data to the State in August in order to receive reimbursement. It is important to get this data reported early so that we begin to receive our reimbursement payments in September. Transportation subsidy is in excess of I million dollars.

We will be reporting the 2023-24 nurse/health reimbursement sometime in August. This reimbursement helps to offset the cost of the district's health offices. The reimbursement is around \$25,000 each year.
