- \$399.99 for the gateway device with a Network Optimization Plan (NOP) contract.
- \$40 per month for unlimited data.
- We won't know if this solution will work until we receive the router. As mentioned during last week's admin meeting, if the router is compatible, it can be used inside and outside the buildings.  
I spoke with Verizon this morning and arranged for a demo router to be sent before the board approves any contracts. If the router **doesn't** meet our needs, we won't be committed to any agreement, and the board will need to reconsider the expense of the alternative wired system that they have already said no to.  
I will keep you posted on Verizon and the demo router!
