Susquehanna Community School District receives \$300K from the Public School Facilities Improvement Grant to be used for HVAC Upgrades

Superintendent John Rushefski is thrilled to announce that \$300,000 was awarded to Susquehanna Community School District for HVAC upgrades. The Facilities Improvement Grant is a competitive grant overseen by the Commonwealth Financing Committee that released a list of award recipients on October 22, 2024. At the October 16 Regular Meeting, the Susquehanna Board unanimously approved this HVAC project, and they now have \$300K to offset the financial impact of just over \$400,000. This funding will ultimately improve the comfort and safety of our learning environments, ensuring a healthier atmosphere for students and staff.
